Recipe Corner

Eggplant With Cheese and Bread Crumb Topping

Ingredients:

- 1 1/2 pounds eggplant, peeled, cubed
- 1 medium onion, chopped, about 1/2 cup
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 3 tablespoons butter
- 3 tablespoons flour
- 1 cup milk
- 1/4 teaspoon salt, or to taste

Dash pepper

- 1 cup shredded Cheddar cheese, about 4 ounces, divided. Can use Mozzarella.
- 1 cup diced tomatoes
- 2/3 cup fresh bread crumbs
- 3 to 4 basil leaves, chopped, or about 1/2 teaspoon dried basil leaves
- 2 tablespoons melted butter

Preparation:

Butter a 2-quart baking dish. Heat oven to 350°.

Put eggplant and onion in a saucepan; cover with water and add salt. Bring to a boil; cover and continue boiling for 10 minutes until eggplant is tender. Drain well..

In the saucepan over medium-low heat, melt 3 tablespoons of butter. Stir in flour until well blended. Add the milk and stir until thickened.

Stir in salt, pepper, and 3/4 cup of the cheese. Stir in the eggplant and diced tomatoes; turn into the prepared baking dish.

Top with remaining cheese.
Combine the bread crumbs with chopped basil and melted butter.
Toss crumbs to mix, then sprinkle over the eggplant mixture. Bake for 25 to 30 minutes, until bubbly and topping is browned. Serves 4.
