

Ever heard of **McTavishing**? – Karen McTavish has invented a marvelous quilting method that is fascinating and gorgeous. Go to her site for more information:

"McTavishing is a background filler which employs long swooping lines and curves - like cartoon hair. It can be made very densely to pack down the background or it can be made loosely to add motion and interest to the quilt top. I use McTavishing in most of my quilts." – Karen McTavish
