

November Meeting

On November 9th, Gina and I are going to host a Jelly Roll Race! There will be prizes! You will want to win, so here's what you can do to get ready.

A Jelly Roll is made up of 40 - 2½ inch strips of fabric. You can buy one or make your own from your stash. Before you come to the meeting, you should sew them together as you would sew binding strips; that is, making diagonal seams corner to corner. Eyeball it, no need for precision (Shirley!). If you've used assembly-line sewing, cut them apart (you'll have a 1600 inch fabric strip), and you are all done with the premeeting work.

At the meeting, you'll need your machine (and the various power cords to make it run!), fabric scissors, plenty of neutral or coordinating thread, and several pre-wound bobbins.

That's it! Gina and I will instruct you further at the race, time it, and award the prizes! It ought to be a hoot!
